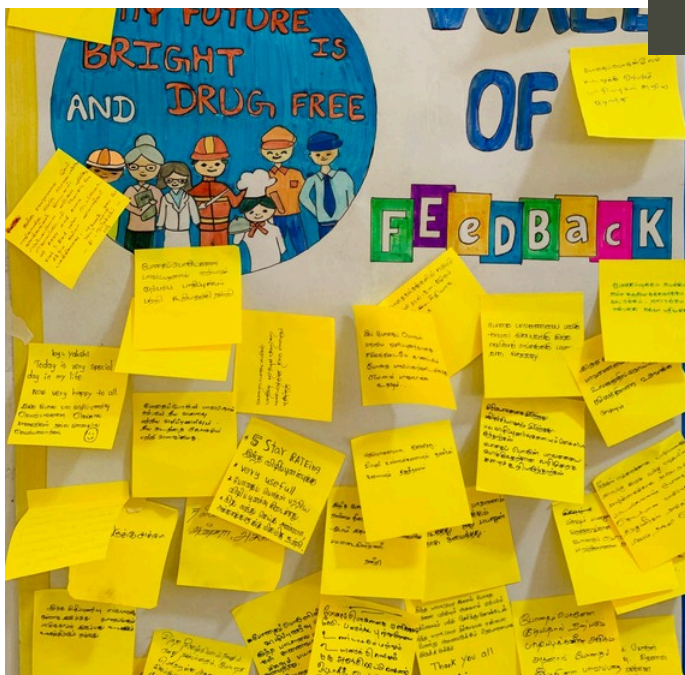

DRUG FREE: THE ULTIMATE FREEDOM

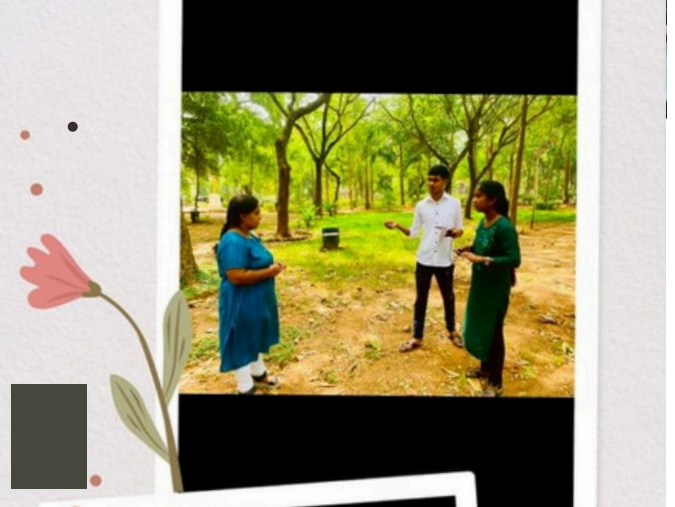
A social action project titled "Drug Free: The Ultimate Freedom" was conducted at T/Mu/Sampoor Mahavidyalayam on October 22, 2024, with the objective of promoting drug-free lifestyles among school students. The project, led by K. Shirley Pausthina, involved a seminar, a short drama play, and a quiz to educate students about the impacts of drugs and prevention methods. The event was attended by 67 students, and feedback collected from participants indicated a lasting impact on their awareness about drug addiction. The project was deemed successful, with the school principal appreciating the initiative's importance in shaping the students' and community's future.

In October 2024, we conducted a series of educational programs aimed at guiding future Advanced Level (A/L) students in making informed decisions about their academic and career paths. Held at Girandurukotte Central College, Orubadiwewa Central College, Dambarawa Maha Vidyalaya, and Halpe Central College, these sessions focused on selecting suitable A/L subjects, choosing university degrees after A/L, and identifying potential career paths post-graduation. Despite challenges such as power outages and scheduling adjustments, the programs successfully engaged students through informative discussions and interactive activities. We also distributed bookmarks featuring QR codes linked to a specially designed webpage, providing easy access to comprehensive resources. These initiatives were well-received, fostering awareness among students about their educational and professional futures.

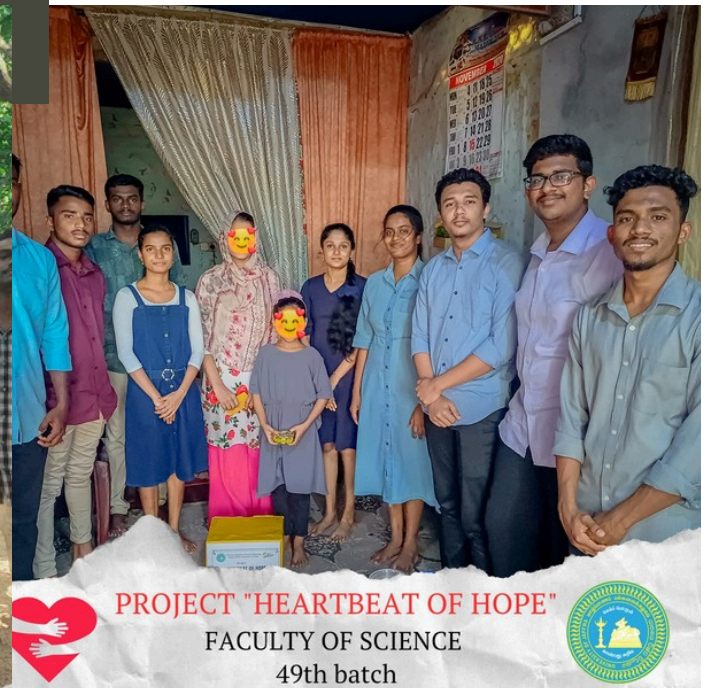

From October 18 to November 14, 2024, we carried out a project to support four pediatric cardiology patients in Batticaloa. After consulting Dr. Anulnithi at Batticaloa Teaching Hospital to discuss the project, we began fund collection efforts on October 22 in Batticaloa Town and October 24 in Kaluwanchikudy. On November 2, during a follow-up with Dr. Rajeevan, it was recommended that financial support would be more impactful than medical assistance. We visited the recipients' homes to assess their needs and, on November 10, purchased essential items from Kattankudy. Donations were delivered on November 12 and 14 to homes in Valachchenai, Kattankudy, Kannankudah, and Vellaveli.

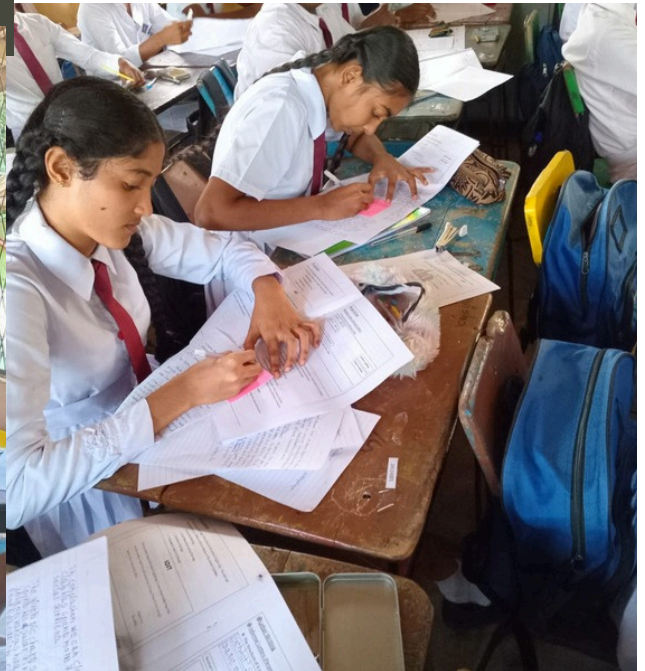
CLEAN WAVES

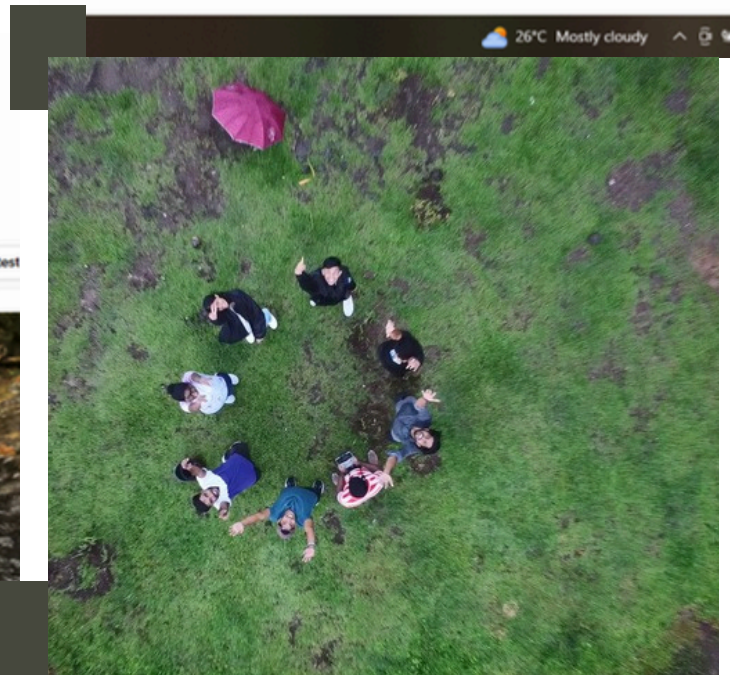
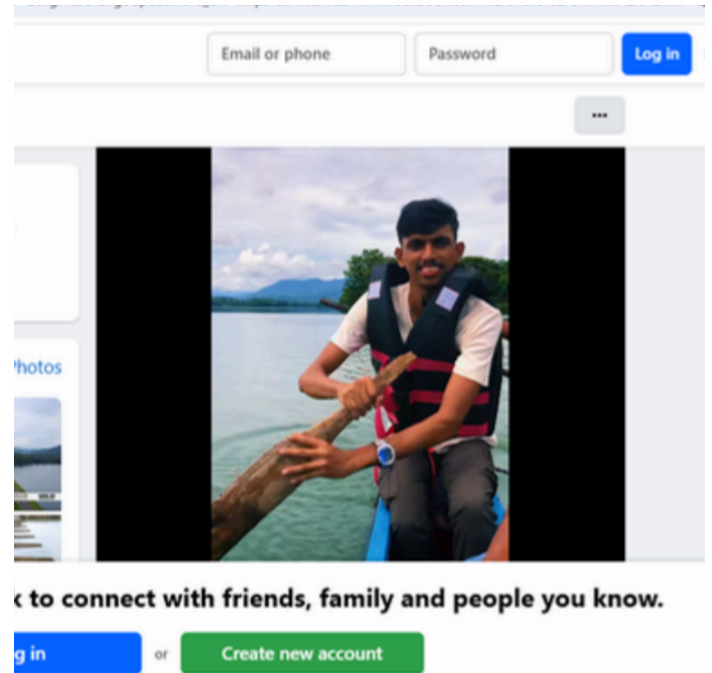
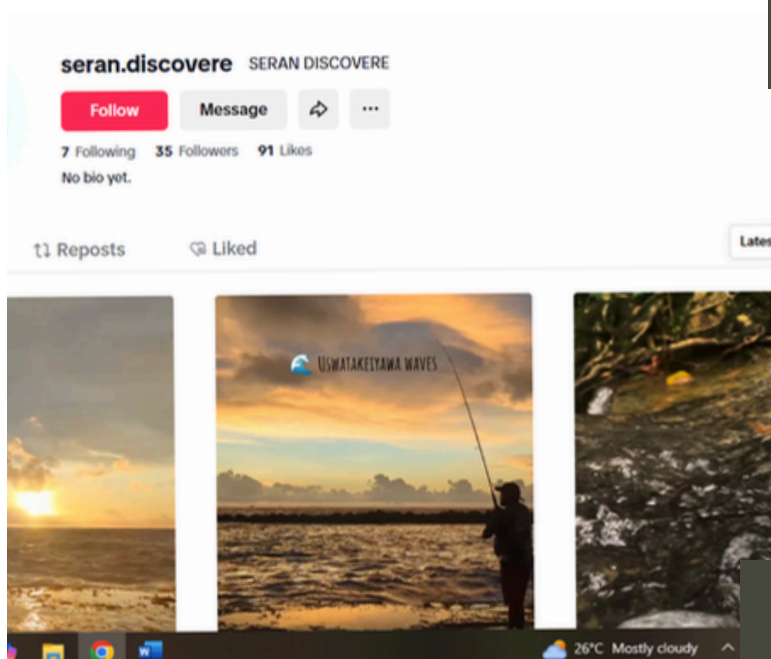
BREAKING BARRIERS
