Open competition to the staff/students

- 1. Documentary video about the functions and activities of the faculty
 - Duration not more than 10 minutes
- 2. **Music video** reflecting the students' life in the faculty and/or hostel
 - Duration not more than 5 minutes
- 3. Short film Reflecting the current social/cultural/economic issues of the individuals and/or society
 - Duration not more than 10 minutes

Open to the respective students' societies

- 4. Documentary video about the department
 - Duration not more than 5 minutes

Open competition to the staff/alumni/students

- 5. **Digital poster -** Awareness poster on UN Sustainable Development Goals
 - Open to the students/alumni/staff
- 6. Video on Promoting STEAM education Duration not more than 5 minutes
 - Open to the students/alumni/staff
- 7. Video on Future outlook of the faculty's infrastructure Duration not more than 2 minutes
 - Open to the students/alumni/staff
- 8. Photograph of faculty premises
 - Open to the students/alumni/staff

Guidelines

1.0 Making Documentary video about the faculty

- 1.1 Documentary video must be no longer than 10 minutes including opening and/or closing credits.
- 1.2 The voiceover and interviews may be in English. Non-English voiceover and interviews, if any must have English subtitles.
- 1.3 Ensure that all content in the video (including footage, music, images, etc.) is your own and must be the original work.
- 1.4 The documentary video must be of the highest quality possible and should be submitted in MPEG4 or AVI format.
- 1.5 The topic of the video should include the following:
 - Scope of the study programmes offered by the faculty.
 - Teaching Learning Environment of the faculty: Laboratories, lecture halls, Study area.
 - Research facilities and activities of the faculty.
 - Facilities are available for recreational and sports activities in the university.
 - Outreach activities of the faculty

2.0 Making Music video reflecting the students' life in the faculty and/or hostel

- 2.1 Each music video must be no longer than 5 minutes including opening and/or closing credits.
- 2.2 Lyrics of the music video may be in Tamil / Sinhala / English. Non-English dialogues must have English subtitles.
- 2.3 Ensure that all content in the Music video (including footage, music, images, etc.) is your own and must be the original work.
- 2.4 The music video must be of the highest quality possible and sould be submitted in MPEG4 or AVI format.
- 2.5 The main theme of the film may be reflecting the university life.
 - Experience (academic and co-curricular activities) at the Faculty of Science
 - Friendship in the university environment
 - Hostel Life: Away from Home
 - Batch and/or field trips

3.0 Making Short Film reflecting the current social/cultural/economic issues of the individuals and/or society

- 3.1 Each short film must be no longer than 10 minutes including opening and/or closing credits.
- 3.2 The main theme of the film may be reflecting the current social/cultural/economic issues of the individuals and society.
- 3.3 Films may be in Tamil / Sinhala / English or have no dialogue at all. Non-English dialogues must have English subtitles.
- 3.4 Ensure that all content in the film (including footage, music, images, etc.) is your own and must be the original work.
- 3.5 The film must be of the highest quality possible and should be submitted in MPEG4 or AVI format.

4.0 Making Documentary video about the Department by the respective students' society

- 4.1 Each documentary video must be no longer than 5 minutes including opening and/or closing credits.
- 4.2 The voiceover and interviews may be in English. Non-English voiceover and interviews, if any must have English subtitles.
- 4.3 Ensure that all content in the video (including footage, music, images, etc.) is your own and must be the original work.
- 4.4 The documentary video must be of the highest quality possible and should be submitted in MPEG4 or AVI format.
- 4.5 The topic of the video should include the following:
 - Study programmes offered by the department.
 - Teaching Learning Environment of the department: Laboratories, lecture halls, Study area.
 - Research facilities and activities of the department.
 - Outreach activities of the department
 - Employment/Postgraduate study opportunity
 - Employment profiles

5.0 Preparing a digital poster

5.1 Content

- The content should provide awareness on one of the 17 UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) (refer the figure in the next page)
- The content should be summarized the possible route to attain the SDG selected.
- The content should be logically connected.
- High level of relevant detail should be presented to provide awareness of the SDG.

5.2 Layout & structure

- Size of the poster should be not less than ~ 80 cm x 60 cm (Landscape)
- Relevant clear figures should be included.
- The poster should be exceptionally attractive in terms of design, layout, and neatness.

5.3 Titles, text and typography

- Title should effectively be highlighted the contents of the poster.
- Font size should be large enough to read the contents.
- Grammatical / spelling mistakes should be avoided.

6.0 Video on Promoting STEAM education - Duration not more than 5 minutes

Open to the students/alumni/staff

STEM Education Classes, Careers & Purposes

- 6.1 Video must be no longer than 5 minutes including opening and/or closing credits.
- 6.2 The voiceover and interviews may be in English. Non-English voiceover and interviews, if any must have English subtitles.
- 6.3 Ensure that all content in the video (including footage, music, images, etc.) is your own and must be the original work.
- 6.4 The documentary video must be of the highest quality possible and should be submitted in MPEG4 or AVI format.
- 6.5 The topic of the video should include the following:
 - STEM vs. STEAM
 - Importance of STEAM Education
 - Benefits of STEM education
 - Careers in STEAM

 - 7.2.2 Lumion for the animation, (https://lumion.com),
 - 7.2.3 Adobe premium for the edit video

8.0 Photograph of faculty premises – Open to the students/alumni/staff

- 8.1 A contestant can submit a maximum of 5 photographs
- 8.2 All photos must be taken by the contestant.
- 8.3 Submissions must be in JPEG format, originally taken by a digital camera.
- 8.4 Entries can be in colour or monochrome.
- 8.5 The file size of each photograph must be less than 10MB
- 8.6 Adjusting your image Digital adjustments are only acceptable if limited to minor cleaning work (removing dust spots), levels, curves, colour, saturation and contrast work.
- 8.7 Photos should not contain any additional information such as names, logos, symbols, or watermarks etc.
